The following are Student Health Insurance premium rates for eligible funded<sup>1</sup> Graduate Associates. "Subsidy" is the amount of the premium paid by the university and is shown on your fee statement/ account as "Fee Auth, GA, Health Insurance." To receive the premium contribution subsidy you must be enrolled for at least 9 credit hours in autumn, winter, and spring terms, and at least 7 credit hours for summer term and continue in an eligible appointment each term.
